What is Pathway to Housing?

WHO:

CrossNet's Pathways to Housing Program provides safe and affordable housing to individuals, families, seniors and/or veterans who are experiencing or about to experience homelessness in the ELANCO community. We currently have one apartment at Trinity Lutheran Church and will be adding two additional apartments in partnership with Petra Church in 2019.

WHY:

There are many barriers for those who are under-resourced, and we believe that each person in our community should have a safe and affordable place to live.

STATS:

According to the Lancaster County Coalition to End Homelessness 72% of all households in Lancaster County are cost burdened & pay 50% or more of their income to rent/mortgage, utilities, & transportation. The average cost for rent in Lancaster County is \$834 per month. A person in a minimum wage job (\$7.25 hr.) would need to work 107 hours a week just to pay their rent.

The number of homeless students in the ELANCO School District in the 2013-2014 school year was 44. In 2017-2018 the total number of students was 74.

In 2010, there were 21% of students participating in the National School Lunch Program compared to 44.2% in 2018.

GOALS OF PATHWAYS:

1. For participants to exit the program, after one year, able to afford fair market rent in Lancaster County.
2. For participants to increase their resources and income.
3. For participants to increase their credit score and receive a favorable housing referral.
