- In the 2018/2019 school year, a total number of 88 students were experiencing homelessness.

CROSSNET HOUSING STATS

From January 2019 through September 2019, the Social Services Department worked with many households to make assessments and build resources. The following describes the support offered.

- Worked with 739 households for case management
- Provided 75 households with rental assistance
- Provided security deposits for 5 households
- Worked with 176 households seeking housing
- Provided 26 households with utility assistance
- Received requests from 146 individuals experiencing homelessness

WHAT IS PATHWAYS TO HOUSING?

WHO:

CrossNet's Pathways to Housing Program provides safe and affordable housing to individuals, families, seniors and/or veterans who are experiencing or about to experience homelessness in the ELANCO community. Those who enter the program stay 12-18 months and pay 35% of their income. During their time in the program, participants build their emotional, physical, spiritual and financial resources.

WHY:

There are many barriers for those who are under-resourced, and we believe that each person in our community should have a safe and affordable place to live.

GOALS OF PATHWAYS!

GOALS OF PATHWAYS:

1. When participants exit the program, they will be able to afford fair market rent in Lancaster County
2. For participants to increase their relational resources and income
3. For participants to increase their credit score and receive a favorable housing referral
4. To have a support system set in place as they continue on their journey

We are excited about what God is already doing through building relationships and building resources with those in the program!

CURRENT PATHWAYS PROJECTS!

CrossNet Ministries kicked off Pathways to Housing at Trinity Lutheran Church in September 2018. The first family has been in the home for one year and has doubled their income! They are closer to the goal to complete the program! The family has reached other goals including parenting classes, financial counseling, budgeting workshops and more! We are excited to expand this program and offer it to more households in the community. In November of 2019, we will have two more apartments ready to house two more families in partnership with Petra Church!

NEXT STEPS!

CrossNet seeks to purchase additional apartments for Pathways to Housing. Our goal is to have ten (10) Pathways to Housing apartments by January 2021. Currently, CrossNet is in an agreement to purchase apartment units. This is part of a larger project that is in a 120 due-diligence period and will be complete in April 2020.
