



Dear Faithful Christmas Donor,

Thank you for faithfully helping our community this Christmas! Your support makes the difference in hundreds of families' lives, and your service is greatly appreciated to help bridge the gap of need in our community.

The Christmas Gift Giving Program is an opportunity for our community to come together to make sure needs are met and families are empowered and loved during the Christmas season. Things will look a little different for our 2020 participating families. This **one-day event** will now be a **DRIVE-THRU** event happening at CrossNet Ministries Youth Center. Registered families will receive Christmas gifts for their children, wrapping paper and tape, stocking stuffers for each child, a free boxed Christmas meal and homemade cookies, all in a drive-thru fashion.

Please note this program is for families **regularly enrolled in the **FREE** lunch program in the ELANCO School District only, or those **financially** effected by COVID-19. All children living in the household are invited to participate in the program. The age range is from birth to 18 years old. If a child is older than 18, they may participate if they are still in high school.*

As a donor, you will receive information about a family you have sponsored. You will receive the children's names, ages, parents' last name and a Wish List for each child. You can decide the size of the family you would like to help. Once you receive the wish lists for your selected family, please refer to the following details to help you finish the process:

- Please spend an equal amount on each child in the family you are purchasing for. It is up to you how much you choose to spend on a family. We also suggest purchasing at least one item from each of the categories on the list, "clothing need," "general need," "a want" and a "book." Gift receipts are helpful.
- You are welcome to provide a parent gift or gift card for the family. We suggest a gift card to a local grocery store.
- Please put **unwrapped gifts in a large black trash bag (one for each child)**, tie closed and clearly print the child's first & last name on the bag, as well as the parents last name. This information is listed on each child's Wish List. **PLEASE** include gift receipts for clothing if possible.
- **Drop all gifts at CrossNet Youth Center at 110 W. Franklin Street during our Christmas Workshop hours Monday, December 7th through Wednesday, December 9th from 9:00 AM to 5:00PM! We will have a few evening hours as well, which will be published later.** (Please note gift purchases made online should be delivered to you **prior** to this date)
- **Optional Ways to Be Involved:**
 - **Gift Card Donations:** Older students love gift cards!! If you want to be involved but do not have the time to shop would you consider donating a \$25-\$50 gift card (Walmart, Target, Amazon) for a teen?
 - **Be a Secret Shopper:** Each year we get last minute gift requests. A secret shopper would take one of these requests and do last minute shopping for us. If needed can supply the gift cards.
 - **Be a Volunteer:** We need individuals to help during our Christmas Workshop and at our Giveaway Event on Saturday, December 12th. Due to CDC regulations space is limited please contact the office for details.
