

Dear Christmas Sponsor,

Thank you for helping our community this Christmas! Your support makes the difference in hundreds of families' lives, and your service is greatly appreciated to help bridge the gap of need in our community.

The Christmas Gift Giving Program is an opportunity for our community to come together to make sure needs are met and families are empowered and loved during the Christmas season. All receiving families participate in a **one-day gift pick-up event** at CrossNet Ministries on **Saturday, December 9, 2023**. Families pick up their gifts, wrap the items themselves, talk to volunteers over cookies and hot chocolate, get stocking stuffers and take their gifts home to give to their children on Christmas day.

As a donor, you will receive information about a family you have sponsored. You will receive the children's names, ages, parents' last name and a Wish List for each child. You can decide the size of the family you would like to help. Once you receive the wish lists for your selected family, please refer to the following details to help you finish the process:

- Please spend an equal amount on each child in the family you are purchasing for. We suggest a spending amount of \$100 per child. We also suggest purchasing at least one item from each of the categories on the list, "something to wear," "something they need," "something they want" and a "something to read." **Please include gift receipts especially for clothing.**
- **GIFT CARD OPTION:** Teens in 9th grade or above can participate in a **GIFT CARD ONLY** option! We all know how hard it can be to buy for older students. We hope this option will help make shopping easier! As you look over your Wish List you may notice some older students will have only one section filled in with a few gift card ideas. We suggest you take one or two of their suggestions and purchase up to **\$100 worth of gift card(s)** for each student that chooses this option. Label and return the gift card with your family gifts as instructed. Feel free to reach out if you need any clarifications for this option.
- You are welcome to provide a parent gift or gift card for the family. We suggest a gift card to a local grocery store.
- Please put **unwrapped gifts in a single large black trash bag (one bag for each child)**, tie it closed and clearly print the child's first & last name on the bag tag, as well as the parents last name. This information is listed on each child's Wish List. **PLEASE** include all gift receipts, especially for clothing and shoes. *Feel free to make copies and use the optional bag identification tags in this packet for each of your sponsored children!*
- Drop all gifts at CrossNet Youth Center at 110 W. Franklin Street during our **Christmas Workshop Week. Monday, December 4th through Wednesday, December 6th** from 9:00 AM to 5:00PM! **We will have a few evening hours** as well, which will be published later. (Note gifts purchased online should be delivered to you **prior** December 4)
- **Optional Ways to Be Involved:**
 - **Gift Card Donations:** Older students love gift cards!! If you want to be involved but do not have the time to shop, would you consider donating a \$25-\$75 gift card (Walmart, Target, Amazon, etc.) for a teen? *Note: this is not the same as the Gift Card Option program.*
 - **Be a Volunteer:** We need individuals to help during our Christmas Workshop Week and at our Giveaway Event on Saturday, December 9th. Space for groups is limited, please contact Lisa for details.
