### **CHRISTMAS PROGRAM IMPACT:**

For over 12 years, CrossNet has ensured children in the ELANCO Community have a blessed Christmas. Prior to this, we supported the ELANCO School District in their program. We have been keeping Christmas stats since 2013! The numbers below represent the total number of students served for that season.

### HOW TO SPONSOR A CHILD



We invite you to share in the Christmas joy this season by being a sponsor with CrossNet Ministries. Sponsorship registration runs September through November each year. Check out our website, or this handbook for more details, or go to www.elancocross.org to download a copy of this handbook.

### WHO QUALIFIES FOR THE PROGRAM:

CrossNet sends out the Christmas Program paperwork and information through local organizations, the ELANCO School District, and churches. Family registration runs from August to November. Children newborn to 18 years old who meet the criteria are excepted into the program.

### To qualify, families must:

- (1) qualify for the FREE lunch program in the ELANCO School District
- (2) be currently living in the ELANCO School District area
- (3) and/or be referred to us by CrossNet Social Workers, ELANCO School Counselors, or a partnering ELANCO church

### **SPONSORSHIP TIMELINE:**

- **1. Anyone can be a sponsor!** This program is a great way for your organization, business, church, community club, or individual to come together to give back during the Christmas season. You can register as either an individual or on behalf of your group.
- **2. Register to be a sponsor:** Simply fill out the short Sponsorship Application included in the back of this Handbook and submit to us by <u>November 22nd.</u> Copies of the application can also be emailed to you or found on our website at www.elancocross.org.
- 3. Receive your Wish List(s): Starting in mid-September, CrossNet begins the overall family matching process. Upon receiving your individual or group application request, you will receive a confirmation email with an attached Wish List for each child sponsored. Wish Lists include general information about the family, children's clothing sizes, and a number of wish list requests. Once you have these in hand you can begin your shopping!
- **4. Drop Off Your Gifts:** Drop off all gifts (and stocking stuffers) at CrossNet Youth Center at 110 W. Franklin Street, New Holland during our Christmas Workshop week that runs <u>December 9th-12th from 9AM to 7PM.</u>
- **5. Event Day:** Gifts, stocking stuffers, and other items will be distributed to families at the Christmas Program Event on Saturday, December 14th from 9 AM to 5 PM at the CrossNet Youth Center.

### IMPORTANT DATES FOR 2024

### **AUGUST 2024:**

 Family Participant Applications & Wish Lists are sent out to potential participating families in partnership with the ELANCO School District.

### SEPTEMBER 2024:

- Sponsorship Applications are available online and via email.
- This is the perfect time for groups and Giving Tree Coordinators to start their preparations. Contact corrine@elancocross.org for specific details.

### **OCTOBER 2024:**

- Consider hosting a stocking stuffer or toy drive. CrossNet has 20 collection bins available to put out in the community.
- Consider hosting a <u>specific</u> toy drive (i.e. all legos, all nerf products, all baby dolls, etc.). Contact Corrine for more details at corrine@elancocross.org.
- Encourage your colleagues, friends, and family to sponsor a family.

### NOVEMBER 2024:

- Collection Drive month!
- Shop, shop! Take advantage of all those early Black Friday sales! Remember to order online items <u>early</u>!
- Volunteer Sign-ups begin! Online sign-up begin November 1, a link will be emailed.
- Family Registration deadline is November 22, 2024

- Workshop Week December 9-12, 2024
- Gift Drop & Stocking Stuffer Drop-Off December 9-12, 2024

### **How Much Money Should I Spend?**

We are asking donors to spend \$100 per child (i.e. \$400 for a family of four). Donors should spend equal amounts of each child gift(s) and if a child has checked the GIFT CARD ONLY OPTION a \$100 in gift card(s) should be given for each child with this option.

### Why Should I Include Gift Receipts?

Gift receipts make it easier for families to return gifts, especially clothing. Sizing on clothing varies greatly between brands and is the main reason we ask for gift receipts.

### Are there other ways to participate besides sponsoring?

Of course! Below are some other ways to partner with CrossNet for this Christmas Program:

- Gift Card Donations: Older students love gift cards! Would you consider donating \$25-\$100 gift cards for a teen? We suggest Walmart, Target, or Amazon gift cards.
- Stocking Stuffer Collections: Donate small items such as gum, candy, socks, toiletries, and small toys to be used as stocking stuffers.
- Cookies: If you love to bake, we are always in need of cookies for our volunteers and parents during Workshop Week and at our Christmas Program Event.
- Wrapping Paper & Tape: This basic need is helpful and used at the Christmas Program Event.

### GIVING TREE DETAILS

YOU CAN SPONSOR A CHILD THROUGH HOSTING YOUR OWN GIVING TREE AT YOUR CHURCH, BUSINESS, OR OTHER ORGANIZATION!

### Planning a Giving Tree

- **Select a Giving Tree Coordinator:** This will be the contact person for your organization to coordinate details with a CrossNet staff member.
  - Create an electronic spreadsheet or checklist with the student name, basic info, and the wish list items listed as a way to track assignments and tag listings.
- Create tags to hang on your tree: You can create your own paper tags or you can print and use pre-made tags from the CrossNet website. Tags include the age and gender of the recipient(s). They should also include a few things on the child's wish list, like clothing sizes so gifters can buy wearable items.
  - Please include a gift drop-off deadline (that coincides with CrossNet's date) on the tag along with a request for the tag to be taped to the unwrapped gift.
  - o **IMPORTANT:** Please include gift receipts for all clothing, shoes, or wearable items.
- Assign "Secret Shoppers": Anyone who wants to help can pull a tag off of the tree. The
  "secret shopper" buys the wish list items for the child on the tag and returns the <u>unwrapped</u>
  gifts to the Giving Tree organizer by the designated deadline, with the tag attached to the
  outside of the gift.
  - We ask donors to spend \$100 per child.
  - People who want to donate gifts to kids but don't want to shop can donate money or gift cards instead, which you can use to buy gifts for unfilled tags.
  - We encourage you to ask shoppers to return their gifts <u>the week before</u> CrossNet's gift deadline to ensure all your gifts are returned.
- Deliver Gifts to CrossNet: When all the gifts for a child are received, place all unwrapped gifts
  for that specific child in a black garbage bag and label with their last name on the outside of
  the bag. Deliver bag(s) to CrossNet for distribution to the recipients on Event Day.
  - All bags need to be at CrossNet by December 12th.
- Organize an Online Giving Tree: You can also organize an online Giving Tree! With an online Giving Tree, donors can give from anywhere. Have online donors ship items directly to you. You can organize and account for their gifts before delivering to CrossNet for Workshop Week (Dec 9–12).
  - **IMPORTANT:** Please ensure online gifts/donations have a delivery date prior to your program deadline.
